Keeping Track of People and Your Progress

Why are we tracking people and calls?

We are tracking the people and progress of GOTV teams as both a measure of success and effort of Common Ground's GOTV 2020 campaign.

We also want to be able to go back to everyone and make sure they vote. We want to collect not just the names of the people we contacted, but who contacted them -- in other words, who has a relationship with them. For example, if Jessica calls David, Tatiana, and Joe about voter registration, we want to be able to ask Jessica to follow up with David, Tatiana, and Joe later to make sure they vote.

Everyone you talk to you have should be reported, not just the people who need to register.

How do I track my progress?

We are tracking people and progress in two ways: Empower or a Google Form. Each team will have access to both tracking tools, and leaders can choose which one they want to use for the campaign.



Keeping Track of People and Your Progress

Tracking with Empower

Empower can be used on your phone, tablet and computer and makes keeping a list of your people easy. With Empower you have access to everyone on your list kept in one place and can record and report your progress for each person while you're on the phone with them.

Create an Empower account. Ask your captain for a link to join Empower. Use getempower.com/CommonGroundWI, if unable to get a link from your captain. If you are asked for an invite code to create an account, use CommonGroundWI.

You have the option to create your account with a phone number or email. Always use the same one you choose to create your account when logging back in, or you'll create a second account. Log back into your account on the phone, tablet or computer at any time using the link web2.getempower.com.

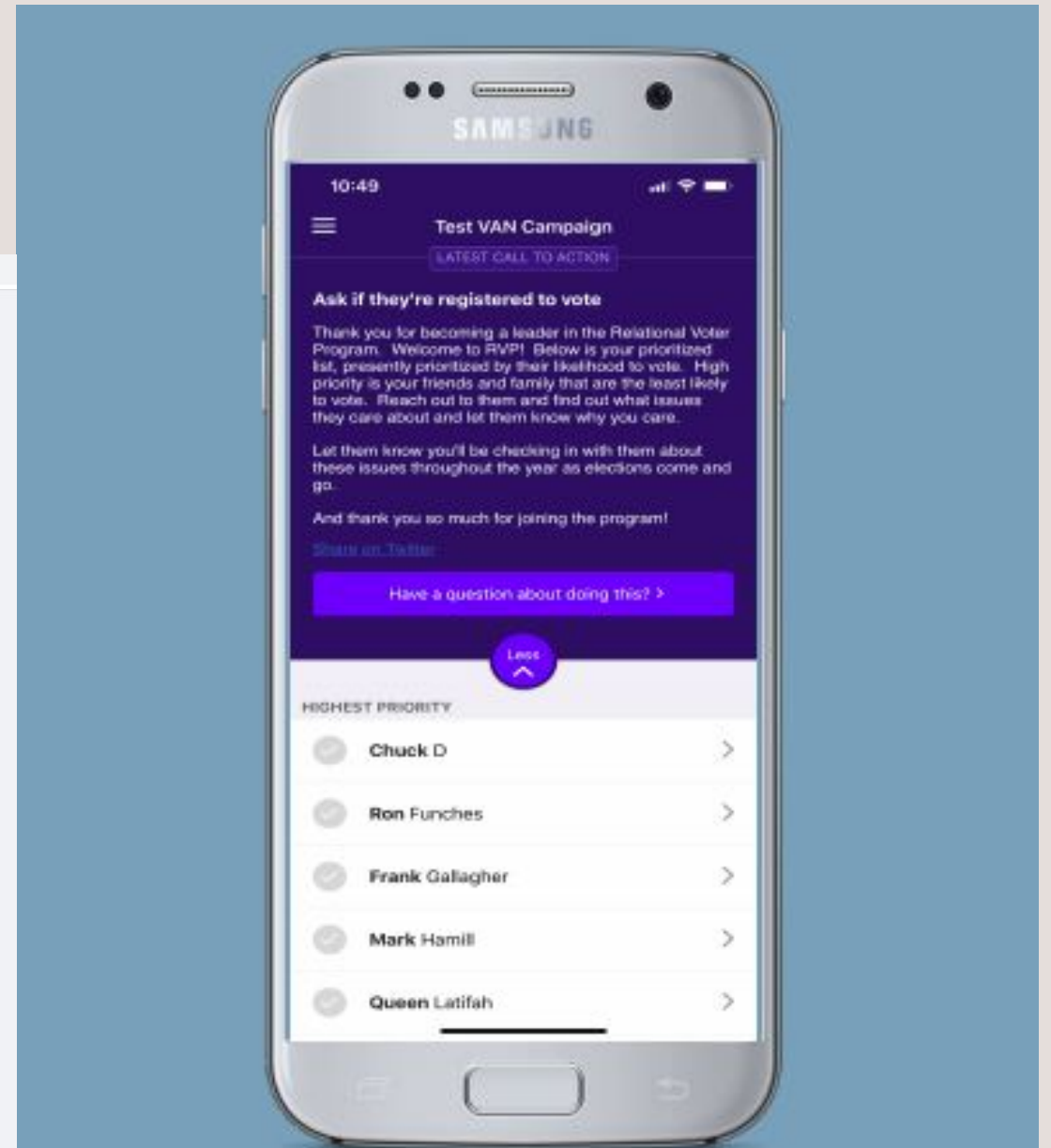

Keeping Track of People and Your Progress

Tracking with Google Form

If you choose not to use Empower, track your people and your progress one person at a time with your institution's Google Form. Save your link to the Google Form somewhere you can access it easily. And fill out the Form during or after every call you make to the people on your list.

For example, if you call a person and they need to re-register and say they'll do it on their own, enter that information. Then, when you call back to follow up, enter that person and conversation again. Two conversations with the same person (first call, follow-up call) = two entries.

Each GOTV team captain is able to see their leaders responses from the Google Form in a spreadsheet after requesting access. If you are a captain, use your institution's restricted link to request access from the GOTV Administrator. Once you have access you can view the latest entries from leaders at any time. The entry responses are automatically fed into the spreadsheet when leaders submit their Form.

HOW TO MAKE THE PHONE CALLS

We make the assumption that you have a relationship with the person you are calling. It is key to your ability to reach them and to engage them in a conversation to help us find 2500 people in Wisconsin who will register or re-register to vote.

RELATIONAL OPENING

Hi! How are you? How's the family? Engage, relate, share stories!

VOTING CONVERSATION

I am working on a Voter Registration Campaign with Common Ground. (Explain Common Ground if need be). We are looking to register or re-register 2500 people throughout the state, particularly in light of what happened on April 7th.

Were you able to vote on April 7th? What did you think of that whole thing?

REGISTRATION

Do they need to register or re-register to vote? If they didn't vote on April 7th, ask "Are you registered to vote?" Have they moved since the last time they voted? If so, they'll need to re-register with their new address. Help them register/re-register at CommonGround.VoteWisconsin.com.



PROPOSITION

Can you help us find 5 people in your social networks that need to register or re-register to vote? We are recruiting 500 people to each find 5 people - you might find more people (or less).

It is particularly important that we do this now because the fall election might be primarily absentee ballots and people need to be registered to get an absentee ballot. We are trying to do this before July 22. (Registration on-line shuts down until after the August 11th primary)

Can you help me?

HOW DOES THIS WORK?

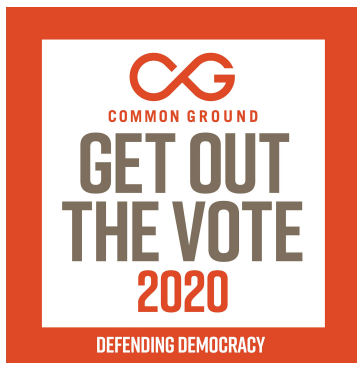
I can send you our info sheet on voter registration. People can register or re-register on-line. Anyone who has moved since they last voted does have to re-register.

They must go through our website: CommonGround.VoteWisconsin.com. Then we can track how we did in getting our 2500 and follow up later with folks about turning out to vote.

I will check in with you once you have the info sheet and stay in touch with how your folks are responding. It would work best if you actually stayed on the phone with them while they register/re-register.

You will need to keep track of your calls using Empower App or our Google form:

- 1) Who you called
- 2) Did you help them register or re-register?
- 3) How many people in their social network will they try to register or re-register?



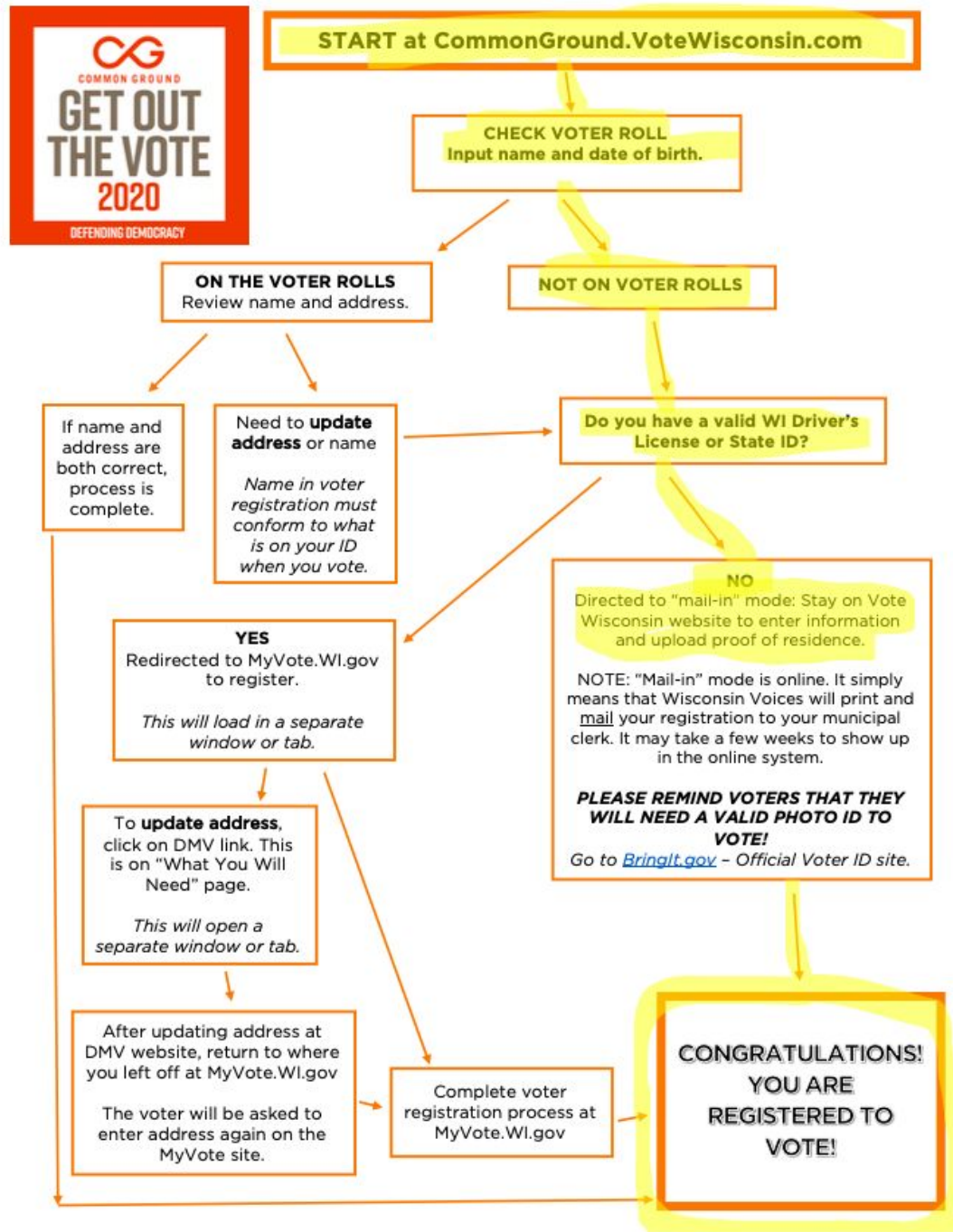
Voter Registration Basics

- Who can vote? To vote in Wisconsin you must be:
 - U.S. Citizen
 - 18 or over on Election Day. *(If voter is 17, they can register now if they will be 18 by next election day.)*
 - Resident of Wisconsin
 - Not currently serving a felony conviction -- “off paper”
- Proof of residence required to register (If you have a valid WI ID or WI Driver's License, that is your proof of residence.)
- ID required to vote - www.BringItWisconsin.com
 - The address on your ID does NOT have to be current. However, the address on file with DMV does need to be current.
 - The name on your ID doesn't need to be an exact match for your name in the poll book. (So, Jennifers who go by Jenny, Bobs who are also Roberts and Daves with IDs for David are fine.)
 - You can get a free state ID which you can use for voting.
- If you move, you must “re-register” by updating your address
- You CANNOT register online or by mail the 20 days preceding an election. You can only register in person during this period. The next blackout period for online registration will be July 23-August 11



Tips for Navigating the System

- Always start at CommonGround.VoteWisconsin.com
- This system is designed to be used by people without any training. It is set up to guide the voter and answer questions along the way.
- You will hear my talk about “Mail-in” mode. Know that ‘mail-in’ mode is actually online. WI Voices has digitized the paper form and they will print it and mail it in for you if you go through our site - CommonGround.VoteWisconsin.com.
- If there’s a problem, there are several options for support listed on your handout. Also, there’s an option to finish later. And switching to “mail-in” mode can solve some problems.

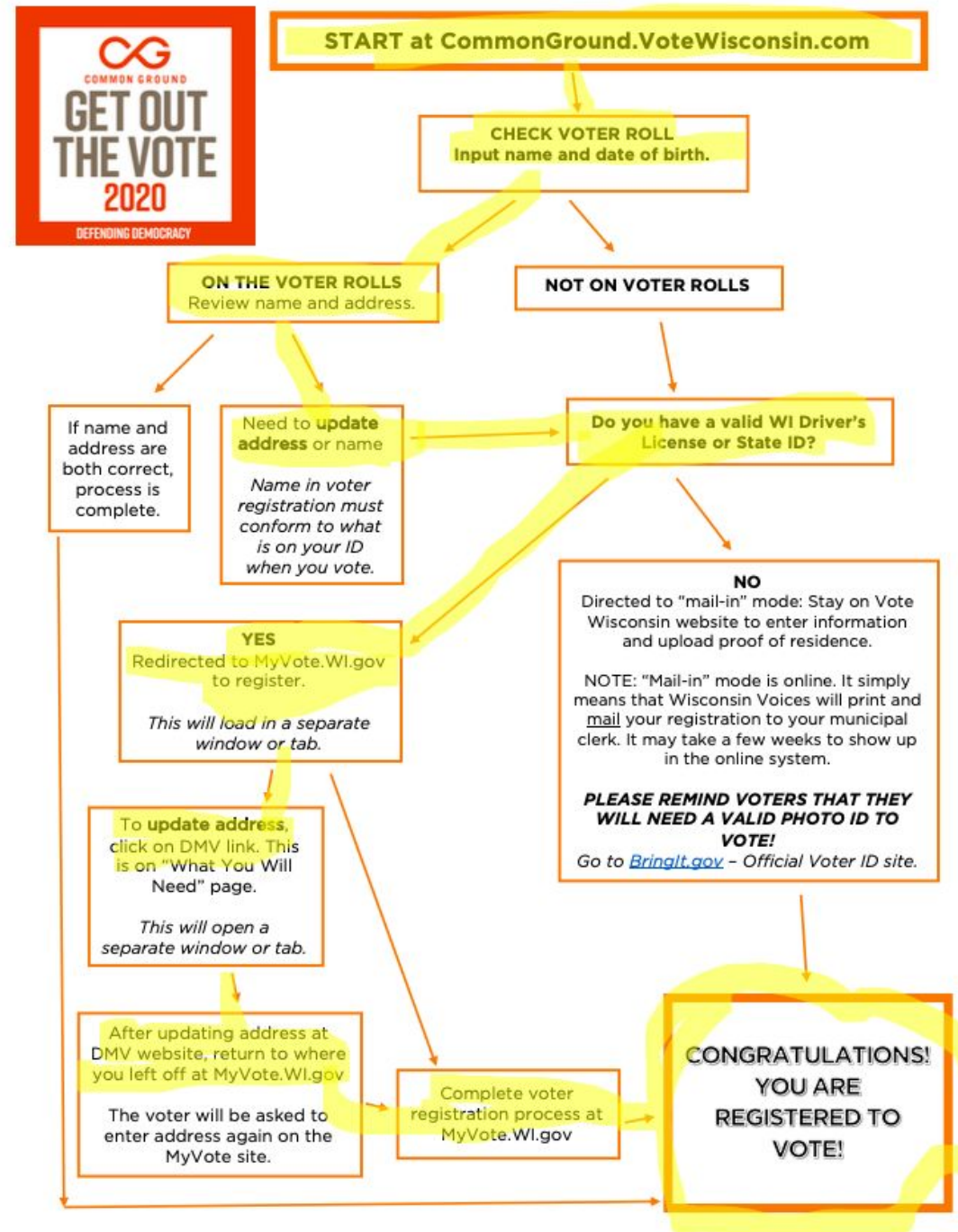

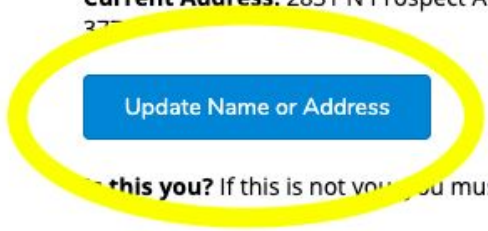

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Step 1: What you will need

There are two ways to register to vote on this site :

1. **Online** : To register to vote online, only voters with a valid, unexpired Wisconsin Driver License or Wisconsin State ID Card may use this site to register to vote. You will need your Wisconsin Driver License or Wisconsin State ID Card Number in order to register to vote online. You will also need to match the name, date of birth, and address on file with the Wisconsin DMV in order to register to vote online. If a match cannot be made with the Wisconsin DMV, you will still be able to register to vote by printing, signing and mailing your registration form along with proof of residence to your municipal clerk.

Need to update your address with the Wisconsin DMV? You will need to have a current address on file with the Wisconsin DMV before you can register to vote online. [Update your address with the Wisconsin DMV here.](#)

If there is an upcoming local election in your area in less than 30 days, you will not be able to register to vote online. You will still be able to register to vote by printing, signing and delivering your registration form, along with proof of residence, to your municipal clerk or your polling place on Election Day.

2. **Mail/Delivery** : Eligible Wisconsin voters who do not have a current, valid Wisconsin Driver License or Wisconsin State ID Card may complete the voter registration form and mail or deliver their form to their [Municipal clerk](#) along with a [proof of residence document](#).
